Central New Mexico Electric Cooperative would like to thank all of our members who attended the 2019 Annual Meeting held in Moriarty on April 13, 2019. With a required quorum of 211 members and a registered attendance of 368, quorum was easily met.

Three trustee positions were up for election this year. District 5, District 7, and District 8. Santos Tapia Jr. was elected trustee for District 5, Duane Frost ran unopposed for District 7 and Bill King was re-elected for District 8.
